English – Literacy

The results in English were very strong with 27% of the cohort gaining marks of 90 and above compared with the 6% of the State. The depth of performance of our students in English is highlighted by the fact that 85% of the cohort gained marks in the 80s and 90s and 98.92% of the girls gained results in the top three bands.

Mathematics

The Mathematics test is challenging for students as it is set at the one level. The 2007 cohort produced pleasing results with 40% scoring 80 and over and 77% gaining a mark between 70 and 95.

Science
