



2007 Higher School Certificate Results

We received our HSC results on 17 December. The course results and the individual student performances are very pleasing. There are many students who have performed to their personal best and they should feel proud of their achievements. From a year group of 63 HSC students, 39 (62%) were on the HSC Honour Roll for gaining marks of 90 and over. In total, Queenwood students amassed 91 marks of 90 and over. Four students were on the All-Rounders Honour Roll for gaining 90 and over in at least ten of their units. *The Daily Telegraph* listed Queenwood as 36th in the Top 200 NSW Schools. *The Sydney Morning Herald*, based on Board of Studies information, ranked Queenwood 28th in the State in their performance in English and 59th in the State in their overall Mathematics performance.

The following list highlights excellence in our students' performances:

Lauren Drake, Julia Grieves, Gabriella Hirst and Jasmin Hyatt received the Premier's Award for All-Round Excellence, gaining marks of 90 and over in at least 10 units.

Lucinda Millsom was first in the State in General Mathematics.

Gabriella Hirst and Ava Shirley were selected for ArtExpress.

Brittany Carr was nominated for the HSC high achievers Music performance, Encore.

Rebecca Boyd-Bais, Jasmin Hyatt and Katia Nazarewicz were selected for the Textstyle HSC State Exhibition.

Congratulations should go to Year 12 and all the staff who supported them in so many ways.

The University Admissions Indices are not released to the school. We can, in part, measure our academic success through an analysis of the Band 5 and 6 results. The tables on the following pages compare the performance of Queenwood HSC students with all HSC students in NSW. The Band 6 column shows the percentage of Queenwood students in each subject who gained marks of 90 and above and compares their performance with the performance of all Band 6 students in the State. The Band 5 and 6 column sets out the same comparison for marks of 80 and above.

The UAIs for 2007

The UAI is a single index that ranks HSC students in the State. The IB uses a table to convert students' total scores in all their IB subjects to a UAI rank. The following data indicates just how well our HSC and IB students performed:

- 29% of HSC and IB students gained a UAI over 95
- 47% of HSC and IB students gained a UAI above 90
- 76% of HSC and IB students gained a UAI above 80
- The top UAI was 99.95
