### Description

The award includes fees remission, proportional to the strength of the application, and additional support as appropriate. Additional support may include but is not limited to: mentorships, funding for attendance at courses or workshops outside of school, working in small groups with likeminded students, funding for coaching or tuition, access to school facilities, assistance with equipment or travel.

All scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion. The School reserves the right in its absolute discretion not to award a scholarship in any particular year or any particular award.

Candidates must sit the Academic scholarship examination on Friday, 16 February 2018.

Portfolios (if applicable), a recent school report, NAPLAN results and two written references must be submitted on the day of the examination. Please mark 'Year 7 Build Your Own Scholarship Attn: Director of Admissions, 47 Mandolong Road, Mosman NSW 2088'. Portfolios will not be returned; please ensure you do not submit original documents. Candidates may be asked for additional information.

Candidates are shortlisted according to both the strength of their application and their performance in the academic test. Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed by the Principal 5-10 March 2018 and final offers will be made prior to 31 March 2018.

Final selection is at the Principal's discretion.
